O R D E R

In this proceeding, L. Cornelius petitions the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing him to transfer to H. J. Hartsell all right, title and interest to his automobile freight route which <sup>he</sup> is at present operating between Rivera and Los Angeles, serving as intermediate points Los Nietos, Santa Fe Springs, Bell and Cudahy.

The total consideration to be paid therefor is given as \$5500.00, it being proposed to transfer one G. M. Truck and trailer valued at \$3,500.00, the balance of the consideration to be paid for the operative rights and good will.

It appearing to the Commission that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be, and the same hereby is granted subject to, the following conditions:

1.

1. That the amount to be paid for the purchase of the property shall not be considered as a measure of value of said property before this Commission or any other authority, for rate fixing or any other purpose than the transfer herein referred to.
2. That the applicant, L. Cornelius will be required to immediately cancel all tariffs and time schedules now on file with the Railroad Commission, such cancellation to be in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51 and other regulations of the Railroad Commission.
3. That the applicant, H. J. Hartsell, will be required to immediately file tariff and time schedule, in duplicate, in his own name, or to adopt as his own the tariffs and time schedules heretofore filed with the Railroad Commission by applicant L. Cornelius, all rates and schedules to be identical with those filed by applicant L. Cornelius.
4. That the rights and privileges herein authorized to be transferred may not be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such discontinuance, sale, lease, transfer or assignment has first been secured.
5. That no vehicle may be operated by the applicant H. J. Hartsell, unless such vehicle is owned by said applicant or is leased by him under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
