O R D E R

In this application Joseph James has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the transfer of an automobile stage line at present being operated by Joseph James for the transportation of passengers between Elsinore and Riverside and intermediate points.

It is proposed to transfer one eleven (11) passenger Studebaker automobile, valued at \$2700.00 and to transfer the operative rights and privileges and good will of the business for a consideration of \$50.00, making a total payment for the equipment and rights proposed to be transferred of \$2750.00.

It appearing to this Commission that this is a matter in which a formal hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be, and the same hereby is granted, subject to the following conditions:

- 1.

1. That the amount paid for the purchase of the property shall not be considered as a measure of value of said property before this Commission or any other authority, for rate fixing or any other purpose than the transfer herein referred to.

2. That the applicant, Joseph James, will be required to immediately cancel all tariffs and time schedules now on file with the Railroad Commission, such cancellation to be in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51 and other regulations of the Railroad Commission.

3. That applicant, Tom Boyle, will be required to immediately file tariff and time schedule, in duplicate, in his own name, or to adopt as his own the tariffs and time schedules heretofore filed with the Railroad Commission by applicant Joseph James, all rates and schedules to be identical with those filed by applicant Joseph James.

4. That the rights and privileges herein authorized to be transferred may not be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such discontinuance, sale, lease, transfer or assignment has first been secured.

5. That no vehicle may be operated by the applicant Tom Boyle, unless such vehicle is owned by said applicant or is leased by him under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
