ORDER

United Stages, Incorporated, and E. B. Stevenson have filed a joint application with the Railroad Commission in which they petition that the Railroad Commission authorize the United Stages, Incorporated, to lease to E. B. Stevenson, certain operative rights covering the operation of automobile passenger transportation between Mecca and Blythe, California.

The proposed lease, which is attached to the application herein and marked Exhibit "A", provides in effect that the United Stages, Incorporated, shall lease such operative rights to E. B. Stevenson for a period of eighteen (18) months at a total rental of Minety (90) Dollars beginning June 1st, 1921 and ending December 31, 1922.

It appearing to the Commission that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the United Stages, Incorporated, be, and it is hereby authorized to lease to E. B. Stevenson, its operative rights to-wit: The right to operate automobile passenger stages over the public highway of the State of California, between

Blythe and Mecca, California, in accordance with that certain lease and agreement filed with the application herein and marked Exhibit "A", provided that E. B. Stevenson shall immediately file with the Commission, in duplicate, tariffs of rates and charges together with time schedules identical with those at present filed by the United Stages, Incorporated, covering operation of passenger service over the above described route, and

Provided further, that no cars shall be operated by the applicant, E. B. Stevenson, unless such cars are owned by him or leased under an agreement satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
