BY THE COMMISSION:

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Railroad Commission having on the 23d day of May, 1921, made its Decision No. 9004 authorizing Bay Point Light and Power Company to collect a surcharge of 10% on bills for electric service based on meter readings taken on and after May 24, 1921; basing said decision on a surcharge of 10% which Great Western Power Company was at that time authorized to collect on its bills for electric energy supplied to Bay Point Light and Power Company.

And Great Western Power Company now being authorized to collect a surcharge of but 6% on its bills for electric energy furnished Bay Point Light and Power Company and the Commission being of the opinion that Bay Point Light and Power Company should collect a surcharge of 6% instead of 10% as heretofore authorized and that this is a matter which does not require a public hearing,

And good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that pending further order of this Commission Bay Point Light and Power Company be, and it is, authorized to charge and collect in addition to its published rates and charges for electric service and in lieu of the present surcharge of 10%, a surcharge of 6% on all bills for metered service based on meter readings taken on and after June 24, 1921.
