ORDER OF DISMISSAL

In this proceeding Carl S. Painter and Albert Ahlman, doing business under the fictitious name of Dos Palos Passenger and Freight Line, have made application to the Railroad Commission for a certificate of public convenience and necessity permitting the operation of an automobile stage line for the transportation of freight, express, baggage and passengers between South Dos Palos and Big Panoche and Little Panoche, via Oro Loma, California.

On April 20th, 1921, a letter was addressed to applicants requesting certain information with reference to their proposed operation. A second letter was addressed to applicants on June 30th, 1921. No reply having been received to either of such communications, on July 1st, 1921, the Commission wrote applicants calling their attention to the fact that neither of the Commission's two previous communications had been replied to. The letter of July 1st, 1921, stated that unless information was received from applicants on or before July 7th, 1921, stating their intention with

reference to the disposition of this proceeding, that their applica-  
tion would be dismissed, and no reply having been received,
