O R D E R

Applicant E. W. Murphy is the owner of operative rights, permitting the operation of an automobile truck line for the transportation of milk as a common carrier between Los Angeles, California, and Downey, Bellflower and Clearwater, California. In this proceeding he applies jointly with A. Harudnian for permission to transfer to the latter such operative rights, together with equipment used in such service.

The consideration to be paid for the property proposed to be transferred is given as Three Thousand (\$3000.00) Dollars, divided as follows:

Two Thousand, Five Hundred (\$2,500.00) Dollars for one Gram truck, 1-1/2 ton capacity, one trailer and 120 ten gallon milk cans.

Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars for the operative rights and good will.

It appearing to the Commission that this is a matter on which a public hearing is not necessary, and that the application should be granted.
