to purchase an Automobile Truck line,
operative rights and equipment used
in the transportation of milk between
Los Angeles, California, and Downey,
Bellflower and Clearwater, California.)

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Applicant E. W. Murphy is the owner of operative
rights, permitting the operation of an automobile truck
line for the transportation of milk as a common carrier
between Los Angeles, California, and Downey, Bellflower
and Clearwater, California. In this proceeding he applies
jointly with A. Harudnian for permission to transfer to
the latter such operative rights, together with equipment
used in such service.

The consideration to be paid for the property proposed
to be transferred is given as Three Thousand (\$3000.00)
Dollars, divided as follows:

Two Thousand, Five Hundred (\$2,500.00) Dollars for
one Gram truck, 1-1/2 ton capacity, one trailer and 120
ten gallon milk cans.

Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars for the operative
rights and good will.

It appearing to the Commission that this is a matter
on which a public hearing is not necessary, and that the ap-
plication should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be and the same is hereby granted, subject to the following conditions:

1. That the consideration to be paid for the operative rights herein authorized to be transferred shall never be urged before this Commission, or any other rate fixing body as a measure of value for a rate fixing or any other purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.

2. That applicant, E. W. MURPHY, shall immediately cancel all tariffs of rates and time schedules at present on file with this Commission and that applicant, A. HARUDNIAN, shall immediately file in duplicate tariffs of rates and time schedules identical in every respect with those at present on file by E. W. MURPHY, or that he shall immediately adopt the tariff of rates and time schedules of E. W. Murphy.

3. The operative rights herein authorized to be transferred shall never be abandoned, leased, sold or assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such lease, abandonment, sale or assignment has first been secured.

4. No vehicles shall be operated by A. Harudnian, except they be owned by him or are leased under an agreement satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
