O R D E R

In this proceeding BOHUMIL CUCENA and E. A. LAVEZZI, doing business under the fictitious name of COMPTON TRUCK LINE, have made application to the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing transfer of their operative rights permitting the operation of an automobile truck line between Los Angeles, California, and Compton, California, serving as intermediate points Watts and Lynwood.

The operative rights herein proposed to be transferred were secured by applicant through purchase from one E.A. Chaffee, such transfer being authorized by Decision No. 8727 dated March 10, 1921. It is not proposed to transfer any of the equipment, the sum of Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars being given as consideration for the operative rights only.

It appearing to the Commission that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary, and that the applications should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the application be and the same hereby is granted, subject to the following conditions:

1. That the consideration to be paid for the operative rights herein authorized to be transferred shall never be urged before this Commission or any rate fixing body as a measure of value for rate fixing purposes, or any other purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.

2. That applicants, BOHUMIL CUCENA and E. A. LAVEZZI, shall immediately cancel their tariffs of rates and time schedules on file with this Commission.

3. That applicant, E. P. TALLON, shall immediately file in duplicate tariffs of rates and time schedules identical with the tariffs of rates and time schedules at present on file by applicants BOHUMIL CUCENA and E. A. LAVEZZI.

4. That the operative rights herein authorized to be transferred shall never be sold, leased, assigned or discontinued unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such sale, lease, assignment or discontinuance shall have first been secured.

5. That no vehicle shall be operated by the applicant, E. P. TALLON unless such vehicle is owned by him or is leased under an agreement satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
