IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, That the applicants be and they are hereby authorized to establish and make effective on and after August

That lat, 1921 a uniform rate of \$1.50 per month to be charged and collected from their subscribers and patrons for telephone service rendered in the vicinity of Cayacos, California.
