O R D E R.

FRESNO CITY WATER CORPORATION, having applied to the Railroad Commission for permission to issue a \$10,000. promissory note in renewal of a note of like amount issued to Bank of Italy-Fresno, pursuant to authority granted in Decision Number 3460, dated December 20, 1920, a public hearing having been held and the Commission being of the opinion that applicant's request should be granted,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Fresno City Water Corporation be, and it is hereby, authorized to issue its one year promissory note in the principal amount of \$10,000. to Bank of Italy-Fresno, for the purpose of paying or refunding the note referred to in this application.

The authority herein granted is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The note herein authorized to be issued shall bear interest at not exceeding 7% per annum.

2. Applicant may, if it so desires, issue the note herein authorized for a term of less than one year and renew said note from time to time, provided that the combined terms of the note herein authorized and those issued in renewal thereof, shall not exceed one year from the date of the first note issued under the authority herein granted.

3. Applicant shall file with the Railroad Commission a statement such as required by the Railroad Commission's General Order No. 24, which order in so far as applicable, is made a part of this order.

The foregoing order is hereby approved and ordered filed as the Opinion and Order of the Railroad Commission of the State of California.
