FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

Good Cause Appearing:

IT IS HEREBY DECLARED that in accordance with the order heretofore made in this proceeding in Decision Number 9238, dated July 15, 1921, Southern California Gas Company has filed with the Railroad Commission a stipulation satisfactory in form, duly authorized by its Board of Directors, declaring that the company, its successors and assigns, will never claim before the Railroad Commission or any court or other public body, any value whatsoever for the franchises which said Southern California Gas Company may acquire from Citrus Belt Gas Company in excess of the amount ac-

tually paid to the various grantors as the consideration for the granting of said franchises, which franchises and which amounts are set forth in the stipulation.
