BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

In this proceeding William C. Peters has applied jointly with G. A. Reichman for permission to transfer to the latter his one-half interest in the operative right, authorizing the conduct of an automobile freight and passenger stage service between Yreka, Etna Mills and Fort Jones, together with his interest in the equipment used in connection with such business.

The operative right, an interest in which it is herein proposed to transfer, was acquired by Peters and Reichman through operation in good faith prior to May 1, 1917, and continuously since.

Applicants also hold U. S. Mail contract between the points named, which contract it is also proposed to transfer to Applicant Reichman.

Applicants ~~also~~ give the sum of Three Thousand, Three hundred and Sixty Dollars and forty-five cents (\$3,360.45) as the consideration to be paid for the one-half interest in the equipment herein proposed to be transferred, such equipment consisting of two (2) motor trucks, one (1) Ford touring car, three (3) stage coaches, together with nine (9) horses and other miscellaneous property.

It appearing to the Commission that this is a matter upon which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be and the same hereby is granted, subject to the following conditions :

1. That the consideration to be paid for the property herein authorized to be transferred shall never be urged before this Commission or any other rate fixing body as a measure of value for rate fixing or any other purpose than the transfer herein authorized.

2. Applicant, William C. Peters, shall be immediately required to cancel tariffs of rates and time schedules at present on file with this Commission and Applicant, G. A. Reichman, shall be immediately required to file in duplicate tariffs of rates and time schedule or to adopt the tariffs of rates and time schedules as at present on file covering this service.

3. The operative rights herein authorized to be transferred shall never be sold, leased, assigned or abandoned, unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such sale, lease assignment or abandonment has first been secured.

4. No vehicles shall be operated by Applicants C & A. Reichman unless such vehicles are owned by him or are leased under an agreement satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
