SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In the above-entitled proceeding the Railroad Commission on June 18th, 1921, issued its order, Decision No. 9117, granting applicant a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the operation of passenger and freight service between Orleans and Langford's Ranch.
