O P I N I O N

The Star Auto Stage Company, a corporation, by its President, W. E. Travis, makes application under Rules 10 and 11 of General Order No. 51 for authority to adjust fares between Sacramento-Stockton-Merced-San Jose-Oakland and intermediate points on basis of 3.3 cents per mile.

This adjustment will result in few increases but numerous decreases.

A stipulation filed by the Attorney for applicant, attached to and made a part of the application, sets forth that should any complaint against the proposed fares be filed with the Commission, the carrier will without necessity of a formal hearing, restore any of the fares sought to be increased.

In view of the fact that the proposed fares will give to the public the benefit of many reductions and in further view of the stipulation of carrier referred to, we are of the opinion this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that this application should be granted.

Subsequent to the filing of the application herein the name of the applicant has been changed to CALIFORNIA TRANSIT COMPANY. The order, therefore, will be directed to the company under its present name.

O R D E R

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the CALIFORNIA TRANSIT COMPANY, formerly STAR AUTO STAGE COMPANY, a corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized under Rules 10 and 11 of General Order No. 51 to publish and file in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Railroad Commission, on five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public in the regular manner, the adjustment of fares set forth in Exhibit "A" in the application in this proceeding, it being understood that should any complaint be made against the fares and charges in this application, that the applicant, CALIFORNIA TRANSIT COMPANY, formerly STAR AUTO STAGE COMPANY, a corporation, will, without the necessity of a formal hearing, restore any or all of the fares so complained of.
