DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, BUREAU OF ENGINEERING, of the CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO, having on September 2, 1913, filed with the Commission plans and specifications for a proposed underpass to be constructed under the tracks of Southern Pacific Company at Santa Rosa Avenue, City and County of San Francisco, and it appearing to the Commission that the plans and specifications filed are for a standard underpass with concrete abutments and steel girder span, to be constructed for the purpose of separating the grades of the tracks of Southern Pacific Company and Santa Rosa Avenue, and that said plans and specifications are satisfactory and meet standard requirements for the separation of said grades, and are in conformity with the Commission's General Order Number 26,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the plans and specifications for said underpass, as filed, be, and the same are hereby approved.
