ORDER

In this proceeding C. A. Richardson applies for permission to transfer and B. E. Vreeland and L. S. Everts apply for permission to purchase a one-fourth interest in the operative rights and equipment of an automobile truck line operated between San Diego and El Centro.

The operative rights, an interest in which it is herein proposed to transfer, were obtained by applicants herein under Decision No. 8001, made in connection with Application No. 5938 on August 23, 1920.

The consideration to be paid for the property herein proposed to be transferred is given as a nominal sum of \$1.00, the proposed purchasers to assume all obligations at present resting against applicant C. A. Richardson, a co-partner.

It appearing to the Commission that this is a proceeding in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application
be, and the same hereby is granted subject to the following conditions:

Applicants herein shall be required to
immediately cancel tariffs of rates and
time schedules as at present on file
in the name of the co-partnership and
to immediately file new tariff of rates
and time schedules identical with those
at present on file in the name of the
co-partnership as now existing.
