ORDER

In this proceeding Mrs. C. W. Mingus, as administratrix of the estate of C. W. Mingus, deceased, has applied to the Railroad Commission for permission to sell and Frank B. Zadikian and Tatos Avolian to purchase the operative rights and equipment in an automobile truck line used in the transportation of milk between Wineville and Los Angeles, serving as intermediate points Chino, Ontario, Pomona, Spadra, Walnut, Puente, and Bassett.

The operative rights herein proposed to be transferred were obtained by C. W. Mingus through operation in good faith prior to May 1st, 1917 and continuously since that date.

The consideration to be paid for the property herein proposed to be transferred is given as the sum of \$5,500.00, of which amount \$3,500.00 represents the value of one two ton Service Motor truck and the sum of \$500.00 as the value of one ton four wheel trailer. The balance of the purchase price, being \$1,400.00 is listed as the value of the operative rights and good will of the business.

It appearing to the Commission that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above-entitled application be and the same hereby is granted subject to the following conditions:

1. That the consideration to be paid for the property herein authorized to be transferred shall never be urged before this Commission or any other rate fixing body as a measure of value for rate fixing or any other purposes, excepting the transfer herein authorized.





2. That the applicant Mrs. C. W. Mingus, as Administratrix of the Estate of C. W. Mingus, Deceased, will be required to immediately cancel all tariffs and time schedules now on file with the Railroad Commission in the name of C. W. Mingus, such cancellation to be in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51 and other regulations of the Railroad Commission.

3. That the applicants Frank B. Zadikian and Tatos Avoian will be required to immediately file tariff and time schedule, in duplicate, in their own names, or to adopt as their own the tariffs and time schedules heretofore filed with the Railroad Commission by C. W. Mingus, all rates and time schedules to be identical with those filed by C. W. Mingus.

4. That the rights and privileges herein authorized to be transferred may not be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such discontinuance, sale, lease, transfer or assignment has first been secured.

5. That no vehicle may be operated by the applicants Frank B. Zadikian and Tatos Avoian, unless such vehicle is owned by said applicants or is leased by them under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
