## FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Railroad Commission having by Decision No. 7808, dated June 28, 1920, authorized SAN DIMAS CHARTER OAK DOMESTIC WATER COMPANY to issue not exceeding \$5,000.00 face value of notes bearing interest at the rate of not exceeding 6 per cent. per annum and applicant having reported that it is unable to renew the notes, the issue of which the Commission has heretofore authorized at the rate of interest fixed by the Commission in its order of June 28, 1920 and that it is obliged to pay interest at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum, and applicant having requested the Commission to modify its order of June 28, 1920 accordingly:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Condition "I" of the order in Decision No. 7808, dated June 28, 1920, be and it is hereby, modified so as to permit SAN DIMAS CHARTER OAK DOMESTIC WATER COMPANY to pay interest at not exceeding 7 per cent. per amount on the notes which it is authorized to issue under the authority granted in said decision.
