ORDER.

Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation,
has applied to the Railroad Commission for an order authoriz-
ing the abandonment and removal of a certain spur track 826.6
feet in length, located at Coyote Station on the Watts-
Redondo Line of the applicant's Southern Division. It is
alleged that there is no further use for this spur track
which was originally located to serve industries and the only
industry which was located at this point has abandoned the
location and moved its plant and buildings to another site
on the Whittier Line of applicant.

An inspection having been made by a representative of
the Commission, the Commission being fully advised and of the
opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not

necessary and that permission should be accorded for the removal of the spur track as herein applied for.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, That this application be and the same hereby is granted.
