ORDER

It appearing from the application on file herein that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Contra Costa, by an order made July 5, 1921, granted to the Grangers Business Association, the applicant herein, a renowal of a certain franchise and the right to construct and maintain a wharf and take tolls thereon, for the term of twenty years on certain land situated and bordering on the Straits of Carquinoz, in said County of Contra Costa, and applicant, pursuent to Section 2906 of the Political Code, having asked the approval of this Commission, of the renewal of such franchise and the granting of such rights; and it appearing to the Commission that such approval should be granted and that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is required.—

IT IS HERREN ORDERED that the Railroad Commission does heroby approve the renewal by said Board of Supervisors of the County of Contra Costa, of said franchise and the granting of said rights referred to in the application.

This order shall not become effective until the applicant herein shall have filed with this Commission a stipulation, duly agreeing that it or its successors and assigns will never claim before the Railroad Commission of the State of California or other public body any value for said franchise, or renewal of franchise rights, granted by said Board of Supervisors of the County of Contra Costa in excess of the actual cost thereof, which cost shall be stated in the stipulation.
