BY THE COMMISSION:

SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION having, by Decision Number 9242, dated July 16, 1921, authorized San Diego and Arizona Railway Company to sell certain equipment consisting of five locomotives and two tank cars at its depreciated value, and applicant having reported that inadvertently the term "Depreciated value" instead of "the present value" was used in the original petition, and that it is the intention of applicant to sell its equipment at its present value which is reported at \$202,400.00 instead of its depreciated book value of \$138,629.37, and applicant having requested the Commission to modify its decision of July 16, 1921, and the Commission being of the opinion that said decision should be modified as herein provided,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the order in Decision Number 9242, dated July 16, 1921, be, and it is hereby, modified so as to permit San Diego and Arizona Railway Company to sell for \$202,400. the equipment described in Exhibit "B" filed in this proceeding, provided that the price at which applicant is authorized to sell said equipment will not be urged before this Commission as a measure of

the value of said equipment for the purpose of fixing rates, or any purpose other than the transfer herein permitted;

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the order in Decision Number 9242, dated July 16, 1921, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this Second Supplemental Order.
