O R D E R

In the above application the Commission is asked to approve two separate transfers of Artesia Water Company (a fictitious title), a small public utility water system supplying some 77 consumers in the town of Artesia, Los Angeles County. The application states that this property was transferred from A. L. Leighton to Fred W. Ridgway and wife in January, 1919, and was in turn on December 14, 1920, transferred to C. C. Ridgway and Pearl Ridgway, his wife, all of whom join in the application.

It appearing to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above application be and it is hereby granted, upon the following conditions:

1. - The authority herein granted refers only to the following property, as described in the application:

"The assets of the company consist of Lots 17 and 18, Block 4, of the Town of Artesia, Los Angeles County, California,

as per Book 8, page 126, of Maps, Records of said County, together with the pumping plant thereon, and the pipe and distributing fixtures connected thereto with which its patrons are served, the value of which at the time of the first transfer in January, 1919, was fixed at \$7,500.00, and which value at the present time is fixed at \$9,000.00."

2. - The consideration given for the transfer of the above described property shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of the value of said property for rate fixing or any purpose other than the transfers herein authorized.

3. - Within thirty (30) days from the date of this order, applicants herein shall file with this Commission certified copies of the instruments of conveyance under which each secures title to the above property.
