ORDER

In this application Warren Slinkard has petitioned the Railroad Commission for a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the operation of an automobile stage line for the transportation of passengers, freight, express and baggage between Eagleville and Cedarville, California.

Applicant states in support of his petition that he is the holder of a sub-contract for the carriage of United States Mail over Route No. 76110, which includes the two points between which he desires to operate as a common carrier,- that under the conditions of such contract he is obliged to operate his service during the entire year, while the existing transportation company between the points mentioned, operates only during the period of the year from April first to November 15th.

In connection with his application, applicant has filed a verified statement signed by F. E. Hanson, President of the Hanson Transportation Company, operating an automobile stage line between Cedarville and Gerlach, Nevada, serving as an intermediate point Eagleville, California, in which statement F. E. Hanson waives all objection to the operation herein proposed.

It appearing to the Commission that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the operation by Warren Slinkard of an automobile stage line as a common carrier for the transportation of passengers, freight, express and baggage between Eagleville, California, and Cedarville, California, and a certificate of public convenience and necessity be, and the same hereby is granted subject to the following conditions:

1. That applicant shall file within a period of twenty (20) days from date hereof his written acceptance of the certificate herein granted and shall file within a period of forty (40) days from date hereof tariff of rates and time schedule, in duplicate, such tariff of rates and time schedule to be substantially the same as the tariff of rates and time schedule shown in Exhibits "A" and "B" attached to the application herein.

2. That the rights and privileges hereby authorized may not be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such discontinuance, sale, lease, transfer or assignment has first been secured.

3. That no vehicle may be operated by the applicant Warren Slinkard, unless such vehicle is owned by said applicant or is leased by him under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
