

Decision No. 9452.

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of George Berg and Lily Berg for an order authorizing the transfer of telephone line and system from George Berg to Lily Berg.

ORIGINAL

By the Commission:

O R D E R

George Berg, owning and operating a telephone system between Panoche and other points in San Benito County, California, known as the George Berg Telephone Line, having made application for authority to transfer said system by gift to his daughter, Lily Berg, in accordance with the terms of a proposed instrument of transfer making the gift and describing the property given, the same being attached to the application as Exhibit "A", and said Lily Berg having joined in the application, and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted; now therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that George Berg be, and he is, hereby authorized to transfer by gift to his daughter, Lily Berg, the telephone system described in Exhibit "A", attached to the application herein, as follows:

"said line runs from the West half of Section Twenty-five (25), in Township Fifteen (15) South, Range Ten (10) East, Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian, in said San Benito County, California, (save and except twenty acres), to

the New Idria Mine, and on to the Aurora Mine, distant from the New Idria Mine about two miles; also a two mile extension to the San Carlo Oil Wells, and a branch line of one and one-half miles to the old George Weaver Place; that said telephone line and system consists of about twenty-five (25) miles of telephone line, six (6) telephones belonging to said line and used by the public, six telephones being on hand in addition thereto, and the switchboard therefor being located within the dwelling house upon said West half of Section Twenty-five (25), now occupied by said George Berg."

PROVIDED, that within thirty days from the date of its execution, a certified copy of the instrument of transfer shall be filed with the Railroad Commission.
