O R D E R

UKIAH GAS COMPANY having asked permission to sell to the Town of Ukiah City for \$13,800.00 all of its physical properties located in or near the Town of Ukiah City, used or useful, for the purpose of supplying gas to the inhabitants of said Town of Ukiah City and vicinity, including the plant for the manufacture of gas together with the pipes and distributing system; and the Town of Ukiah City having joined in the application; a public hearing having been held and it appearing that the Town of Ukiah City is operating the gas plant under a lease dated September 1, 1920 and that it intends to continue to render service to all consumers now connected with the gas distributing system and to make certain improvements; and the Commission being of the opinion that this application should be granted;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the UKIAH GAS COMPANY be, and it is hereby, authorized to sell free and clear of all encumbrances on or before December 1, 1921, to the TOWN OF UKIAH CITY.

for \$13,800.00, all of its physical properties located in or near the Town of Ukiah City, used or useful, for the purpose of supplying the inhabitants of the Town of Ukiah City and vicinity with gas, including the plant for the manufacture of gas together with the pipes and distributing system.
