O R D E R

Mannel J. Simas, owner of a small domestic water system, serving the inhabitants of Avila, San Luis Obispo County, having asked authority to transfer to A. E. Ruda said water system and said A. E. Ruda having joined in the application, and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case on which a public hearing is necessary:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application insofar as it relates to the transfer of public utility properties, be, and it is hereby granted upon the following conditions and not otherwise:

1. The property herein authorized to be transferred is described as follows:

One windmill, two tanks, gasoline engine and pump and all pipe and fittings now in use in the operation of the system of Mannel J. Simas, together with all other pipe and fittings not now in use but belonging to said system, and all rights of said Mannel J. Simas to deliver water to the residents of Avila, San Luis Obispo County.

2. The consideration given for the transfer of

said water system shall not be taken as representing the value of said system for rate fixing purposes.

3. The authority herein granted to transfer said system shall apply only to such transfer as may be made on or before December 31, 1921.

4. A certified statement shall be filed with the Commission by A. E. Ruda not later than ten days subsequent to the date of transfer, indicating the date upon which he actually acquired control and possession of this public utility.

5. A certified copy of deed transferring property herein authorized to be transferred shall be filed with the Commission by A. E. Ruda within thirty days of the date of such transfer.
