ORDER

In this proceeding F. R. Cooley has applied to the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing him to sell and C. T. Cooley for an order authorizing him to purchase the one-half interest of the former in an automobile stage line operated at the present time by F. R. Cooley and C. T. Cooley, for the transportation of passengers between Taft and Maricopa.

The operative rights, a one-half interest in which it is herein proposed to transfer, were obtained by F. R. and C. T. Cooley through operation in good faith prior to May 1st, 1917 and continuous since that date.

The applicants give as consideration to be paid for the property herein proposed to be transferred, the sum of \$1,000.00 which includes all right, title and interest and good will to the one-half interest of F. R. Cooley in the above mentioned stage line.

It appearing to the Commission that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be, and the same hereby is granted subject to the following conditions:

1.

1. That the consideration to be paid for the property herein authorized to be transferred shall never be urged before this Commission or any other rate fixing body as a measure of value for rate fixing or any purposes other than the transfer herein authorized.

2. That applicants F. R. and C. T. Cooley shall immediately cancell all tariff of rates and time schedules at present filed with the Railroad Commission covering the operative rights herein authorized to be transferred, and applicant C. T. Cooley shall immediately file, in duplicate, tariff of rates and time schedules identical with the tariff of rates and time schedules at present on file covering the route which he is herein authorized to purchase, or adopt as his own the tariff of rates and time schedules at present on file by F. R. and C. T. Cooley.

3. That the rights and privileges herein authorized to be transferred may not be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such discontinuance, sale, lease, transfer or assignment has first been secured.

4. That no vehicle may be operated by the applicant, C. T. Cooley unless such vehicle is owned by said applicant or is leased by him under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
