ORDER

In this proceeding Ralph M. Follows has petitioned the Railroad Commission for a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the establishment of an automobile and horse stage line for the transportation of passengers, freight and baggage between Azusa and points in the San Gabriel Canyon.

Applicant is at the present time engaged in the operation of an automobile stage from Azusa to a point approximately eight miles up the San Gabriel Canyon, which is the end of the automobile road, passengers, baggage and freight are there transferred to horse stages for transportation to the various camps and summer resorts from ten to twelve miles further up the Canyon.

At the present time there is no means of transportation between the points proposed to be served except by private conveyance and applicant herein proposes to operate in such service one ten-passenger Reo automobile, three 4-horse stages and two freight wagons.

It appearing to the Commission that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted,
