O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, having on Sep-
tember 12, 1921, filed with the Commission an application for per-
mission to construct a spur track at grade across Firebaugh Avenue,
in the City of Exeter, County of Tulare, California, as hereinafter
indicated, and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a
case in which a public hearing is necessary; that the necessary
franchise or permit has been granted by the Board of Trustees of
the City of Exeter, for the construction of said crossings at
grade, and it further appearing that it is not reasonable nor
practicable to avoid a grade crossing with said Firebaugh Avenue,
and that this application should be granted subject to the con-
ditions hereinafter specified.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that permission be hereby granted
Southern Pacific Company to construct a spur track at grade across
Firebaugh Avenue, in the City of Exeter, County of Tulare, Calif-
ornia, described as follows:

Commencing at a point in the northerly line at
Firebaugh Avenue, said point of commencement being
located 28 feet westerly from, measured at right
angle to, Engineer Station 3366 plus 85, said
Engineer Station being a point in the center of
Southern Pacific Railroad Company Fresno Branch
main line; said point of commencement also being
located 210 feet more or less easterly, measured
