ORDER OF DISMISSAL

In cases numbered 1628 - 1629 - 1630 and 1631 the
Redwood Manufacturers Company made complaint against the Atchison,

Topeka & Santa Fe Railway Company and Southern Pacific Company alleging that these defendants' lumber rates from Pittsburg, Cal. to various points in Southern California are unjust, unreasonable, unjustly discriminatory, unduly prejudicial and injurious to the business of the complainant. Hearings were held in these proceedings in San Francisco on September 21 and 22, 1921. At the hearing on September 21 it was announced by complainant's counsel that complainant and defendants had agreed upon an adjustment of rates and requested the Commission to hold open these cases until the rates so agreed upon were published. At that time the agreed rate schedules had not been worked out and the hearing was then adjourned until the agreed rates could be submitted, which was done at the hearing on September 22, 1921.

Now comes the complainant, through its attorneys, and makes written request under date October 18, 1921 that the complaints in Cases 1628 - 1629 - 1630 and 1631 be dismissed, in view of the fact that defendants had published the rates agreed upon.

The Commission being fully advised believes that these cases should be dismissed.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, for good cause appearing, that Cases 1628 - 1629 - 1630 and 1631 should be and the same are hereby dismissed without prejudice to any party concerned therein.
