THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY reports that during July and August, 1921, it expended the sum of \$2,194,750.99 for plant extensions, additions and betterments. In its third supplemental petition filed in the above entitled matter, it asks permission to use not exceeding \$2,194,750.99 of the proceeds obtained or to be obtained from the sale of stock, the issue of which has heretofore been authorized by the Commission to finance its July and August construction expenditures, which are reported in some detail in Exhibit "3" filed with the third supplemental petition in the above entitled matter.

The engineering department of the Commission has examined the reported expenditures and finds them to be reasonable.

It appears that applicant's request should be granted and THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY be, and it is hereby, authorized to use not exceeding \$2,194,750.99 of the proceeds from the sale of stock authorized by decisions in Applications Nos. 2743, 4790, 5312 and 6426 to finance the cost of the plant extensions, additions and betterments referred to in applicant's third supplemental petition in the above entitled matter

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, that the orders in decisions in Applications Nos. 2743, 4790, 5312 and 6426 shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this Third Supplemental Order.
