SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Under date of September 12th, 1921, the Railroad Commission issued its Decision No. 9493 in which decision it granted applicant J. E. Hodge a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the operation of a passenger stage between Visalia and Maranjo serving as intermediate points Clink, Redbank, Woodlake Junction, and Woodlake, such certificate providing that applicant should file within a period of fifteen (15) days from date thereof duplicate copies of schedules and tariffs covering the proposed service and that such service should be commenced within a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days from date thereof.

On September 27, 1921, the Railroad Commission received a letter from the Attorney representing applicant in which he stated that applicant did not desire to accept the certificate as granted. As the conditions contained in such order have not been complied with and applicant has failed to file formal petition for rehearing within the time specified under the rules of procedure of this Commission,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate granted to J. E. Hodge under Decision No. 9493 be, and the same hereby is vacated and set aside and the above entitled application be, and the same hereby is dismissed.
