ORDER

Ida P. Gardiner, Ida Jewel Gardiner, C.L.P. Gardiner,
Crete G. De Back and J. W. Gardiner having applied to the
Railroad Commission for an order approving the grant of au-
thority of the Board of Supervisors of Sacramento County to
applicants to maintain their wharf, extending into the waters
of the Sacramento River, on the easterly bank thereof, at
Isleton, Sacramento County, and to collect tolls and wharfage
for the use of the same; and a public hearing upon said appli-
cation not appearing necessary,--

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the Railroad Commission of the
State of California that the application be, and it is hereby
granted; and said Railroad Commission does hereby approve the
franchise heretofore granted October 17, 1921, by said Board of
Supervisors of Sacramento County, authorizing said applicants
to maintain said wharf, and to charge and collect tolls for the

use thereof, for the period ending September _____, 1941.
