ORDER

Application having been made jointly as entitled above, for authority to transfer from Moss Beach Realty Company to Granite Rock Water Company all the lands, properties and rights devoted to the service of water in Moss Beach and vicinity, in accordance with the terms of a certain deed which is attached to the application, a public hearing having been held, the Railroad Commission being fully advised in the premises, and it appearing that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be and it is hereby granted, upon the following conditions.

1. The authority granted to transfer said water system shall apply only to such transfer as may have been made on or before December 1, 1921.
2. The consideration given for the transfer of said water property shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of value of said properties for rate fixing or any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.

3. A certified copy of the instrument of conveyance shall be filed with the Railroad Commission by the Granite Rock Water Company within thirty (30) days from the date on which it is executed.
4. Within ten (10) days from the date on which Moss Beach Realty Company actually relinquishes control and possession of the properties herein authorized to be sold, said Company shall file with the Commission a certified statement indicating the date on which it relinquished such control and possession.

The foregoing order is hereby approved and ordered filed as the order of the Railroad Commission of the State of California.
