ORDER

In this proceeding F. J. Roberti has made application to the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing him to sell and M. M. Olsen and F. G. Word, co-partners for an order authorizing them to purchase and operate an automobile stage line used in the transportation of passengers and baggage between Portola and the Nevada State Line to Reno, serving as an intermediate point Backwith, California.

The operative right herein proposed to be transferred was obtained by F. J. Roberti under Decision No. 9377 in Application No. 6658, dated August 18, 1921. The consideration to be paid for the property herein proposed to be transferred is given as the sum of \$1,200.00. This consideration, however, also includes an amount to be paid for the operative right at present held by F. J. Roberti between Reno, Nevada and the California State Line. In authorizing the transfer as herein applied for, it will be distinctly understood that this Commission in no way passes upon the value of the property proposed to be transferred nor the consideration to be paid therefor except insofar as necessary for the present proceeding.

It appearing to the Commission that a public hearing is not necessary in this matter and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be, and the same hereby is granted subject to the following conditions:

1. That the consideration to be paid for the property herein authorized to be transferred shall never be urged before this Commission or any other rate fixing body as a measure of value of said property for rate fixing or any other purpose than the transfer herein authorized.

2. That applicant F. J. Roberti shall immediately cancel all tariffs and time schedules now on file with the Railroad Commission, such cancellation to be in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51 and other regulations of the Railroad Commission.

3. That applicants M. M. Olsen and F. G. Word, co-partners, shall immediately file tariff and time schedule, in duplicate, in their own name, or adopt as their own the tariffs and time schedules heretofore filed with the Railroad Commission by applicant Roberti, all rates and time schedules to be identical with those filed by applicant Roberti.

4. That the rights and privileges hereby authorized to be transferred may not be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such discontinuance, sale, lease, transfer or assignment has first been secured.

5. That no vehicle may be operated by the applicants, Olsen and Word, co-partners, unless such vehicle is owned by said applicants or is leased by them under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
