FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

IT IS HEREBY DECLARED, that in accordance with the order heretofore made in this proceeding on October 14, 1921, PUENTE PACKING COMPANY has filed a stipulation satisfactory in form, duly authorized by its Board of Directors, declaring that neither said company, its successors nor assigns, will ever urge the Railroad Commission of the State of California, or other public body having jurisdiction, to include in a rate base any amount received from the sale of its stock which may be expended for the acquisition of non-public utility property.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, that the order in Decision No. 9609, dated October 14, 1921, shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this First Supplemental Order.
