SEVENTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

THE CALIFORNIA OREGON POWER COMPANY, in its seventh supplemental petition filed in the above entitled matter, reports that during the month of September, 1921, it expended for capital purposes, the sum of \$73,619.07. Applicant asks permission to use \$73,619.07 of the proceeds obtained from the sale of the first and refunding mortgage bonds, or interim certificates, which were authorized to be issued and sold by Decision Number 8731, dated March 10, 1921, as amended, to finance these expenditures which are reported in detail in Exhibit "A" attached to the seventh supplemental petition.

It appears to the Railroad Commission that applicant's request should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that The California Oregon Power Company, be, and it is hereby, authorized to expend an additional \$73,619.07 of the proceeds obtained from the sale of the first and refunding mortgage bonds, or interim certificates which were authorized to be issued and sold by Decision Number 8731, dated

March 10, 1921, as amended, for the purpose of financing the capital expenditures reported in the Seventh Supplemental Petition in this proceeding.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the order in Decision Number 8731, dated March 10, 1921, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect except as modified by this Seventh Supplemental Order.
