FOURTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY having applied to the Railroad Commission for permission to use the proceeds obtained or to be obtained from the sale of \$1,000,000.00 of its common capital stock, the issue and sale of which has heretofore been authorized by the Railroad Commission, to reimburse itself in part for moneys expended in paying \$1,000,000.00 of its 7 per cent. debentures that became due on January 15, 1921, and the Railroad Commission being of the opinion that the request should be granted;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY be, and it is hereby, authorized to use the proceeds obtained or to be obtained from the sale of \$1,000,000.00 of the common stock authorized to be issued by decisions in Applications Numbers 2743, 4790, 5312 and 6426, to reimburse itself in part for moneys expended by it in paying the \$1,000,000.00 of debentures that matured on January 15, 1921, and referred to in the fourth supplemental petition filed in the above entitled matter.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, that the orders in decisions in Applications Numbers 2743, 4790, 5312 and 6426 shall remain in

full force and effect except as modified by this Fourth Supplemental Order.
