O R D E R

HERBERT F. BROWN, INCORPORATED, acting as a public utility in supplying water for domestic and industrial purposes to portions of the City of Richmond, County of Contra Costa, asks for permission to transfer to East Bay Water Company certain portions of its system described in the application as "lying North of Clinton Avenue, East of Thirteenth Street, South of California Street and West of Twenty-third Street; also to certain residences located on Rheem and Lowell Streets and Andrade Boulevard, in said City of Richmond, supplied by mains of said HERBERT F. BROWN, INCORPORATED, which said mains connect with the main lying on Twenty-third Street and extending East a distance of approximately four blocks on each of the above mentioned streets," without consideration;

And East Bay Water Company having joined in the application and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary, and that the application should be granted;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be and it is hereby granted, subject to the following conditions:

1. The property herein authorized to be transferred is as described in the application herein.
2. The authority herein granted to transfer said water system shall apply only to such transfer as may have been made on or before July 1, 1922, and a certified copy of the instrument of conveyance shall be filed with the Commission by Herbert F. Brown, Incorporated, within thirty days of the date on which it is executed.
3. Within ten days of the date on which Herbert F. Brown, Incorporated, actually relinquishes control and possession of the properties herein authorized to be transferred, he shall file with the Railroad Commission a certified statement indicating the date on which he relinquished such control and possession.
