Langstaff, having made application for permission to sell to Fred Rupley for the sum of \$750.00 all their right, title and interest in and to the property of the Forest Hill Telephone Exchange at and in the vicinity of Forest Hill, Placer County, California, and to be relieved of their public utility obligations therein; Fred Rupley having joined in the application; the Commission being of the opinion that a hearing is not required, and that public convenience and necessity will be served by the transfer,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that M. C. and C. W. Langstaff be, and they are, hereby authorized to sell to Fred Rupley for the sum of \$750.00 all their right, title and interest in and to the property of the Forest Hill Telephone Exchange, located at and in the vicinity of Forest Hill, California, and more particularly described in an inventory attached to the application, upon the following conditions:

1. That the transfer herein authorized shall be completed within sixty (60) days from the date of this order.
2. That within ninety (90) days from the date of this order, a certified copy of the deed shall be filed with the Commission.
