FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Railroad Commission having on September 14, 1921 issued its Decision No.9516 in the above entitled proceeding ordering Southern California Telephone Company among other things to at once proceed with the construction and installation of such plant and equipment, if any, in addition to that at present available for the purpose and to complete such construction and installation and place in service a local central office telephone exchange in the Culver City and Palms area within a period not to exceed ninety (90) days from said date, unless for good cause shown the Commission may grant such extension of time as to it may appear to be reasonable and proper and may issue its supplemental order providing therefor; and Southern California Telephone Company having on December 12, 1921 advised the Commission that it will be unable to complete said construction and installation within the time specified and having asked for an extension of time for the completion of said work to January 15, 1922, and it appearing to the Commission that the extension of time therein requested should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time within which Southern California Telephone Company shall complete said construction and installation is extended to January 15, 1922..
