FIFTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

SAN DIEGO CONSOLIDATED GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY having
reported that during the month of October, 1921, it expended for
extensions, additions and betterments the sum of \$124,028.54, as shown
in Exhibit "1" filed with the sixth supplemental petition in the
above entitled matter, and having asked permission to use not ex-
ceeding \$42,214.48 of the proceeds obtained from the sale of the
first and refunding mortgage bonds which were issued and sold pur-
suant to authority granted in Decision No. 8956, dated May 9, 1921,
as amended, to finance in part these expenditures;

AND the Railroad Commission being of the opinion that
applicant's request should be granted;

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that SAN DIEGO

CONSOLIDATED GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY be, and it is hereby, authorized to expend not exceeding \$42,214.48 of the proceeds obtained from the sale of the bonds which were issued and sold pursuant to authority granted in Decision No. 8956, dated May 9, 1921, as amended, to finance construction expenditures not otherwise capitalized and made by applicant during the month of October, 1921, all as more particularly set forth in the Sixth Supplemental Petition filed in this proceeding.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, that the order in Decision No. 8956, dated May 9, 1921, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect except as modified by this Fifth Supplemental Order.
