This Commission having, on July 3, 1912, made its order upon application No. 64 granting to Oro Electric Corporation permission to serve all of Butte County except the cities and towns of Chico, Biggs and Gridley, and Oro Electric Corporation having applied to this Commission for a certificate permitting it to serve the California Rice Milling Company within the City of Biggs; and it appearing that the Board of Trustees of the city of Biggs has given its consent to the service of the California Rice Milling Company by applicant for the reason that the amount of current required by the California Rice Milling Company is far in excess of the ability of the city to supply through its municipal plant; and it appearing further that the Pacific Gas and Electric Company is not opposed to the granting of this application.--

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Oro Electric Corporation be, and it hereby is, permitted to serve the California Rice Milling Company within the City of Biggs, Butte County, California.
