ORO WATER LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY having filed with this Commission its application for permission to charge and collect in the seven cases specified in the application rates for water less than those shown in its published schedule of rates filed with this Commission on April 11, 1912, and this Commission having as yet been unable to make the investigations which it may hereafter make into the question of deviations of public utilities from schedules of rates filed with this Commission and this Commission being willing in the meantime to permit applicant to make the deviations specified in its application.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be and the same is hereby granted to Oro Water Light and Power Company, until the further order of this Commission, to charge and collect rates for water as specified in its said application less than the charges shown on its schedules on file with this Commission.
