THE SOUTHERN SIERRAS POWER COMPANY for

sell and transfer to the Fontana Power
Company a certain branch electrical

ornia, and heretofore used by the Appli-
cant Company in its service North of
Merrill Avenue in Fontana Townsite.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

The Southern Sierras Power Company having applied to the Railroad Commission for authority to transfer to Fontana Power Company that certain branch electrical transmission line extending from Merrill Avenue to Blanchard Avenue in Fontana Townsite, and the Railroad Commission having on the 27th day of June 1921, issued its Decision No. 9167 authorizing said transfer, and

The Southern Sierras Power Company, Fontana Power Company and Southern California Edison Company having joined in a supplemental application alleging that said property is desired to be sold by The Southern Sierras Power Company to Southern California Edison Company and not to Fontana Power Company as heretofore authorized and the authority heretofore granted by the Railroad Commission by its Decision No. 9167 having lapsed through the limitation of time and the Railroad Commission being of the opinion that the authority now sought should be granted and that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary.

The

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Southern Sierras Power Company be, and it is, authorized to sell and Southern California Edison Company to buy, pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth in the form of agreement filed with the supplemental application in this proceeding and marked Exhibit "B", the public utility property described in said Exhibit "B".

The authority herein granted is upon the following conditions and not otherwise:

(1) The consideration at which public utility property is herein authorized to be transferred shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as fixing its value for any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.

(2) Southern California Edison Company shall, within thirty days after the execution thereof, file with the Railroad Commission a certified copy of the instrument of conveyance under which it secures title to the public utility property referred to herein.

(3) The authority herein granted will apply only to such transfer as may be made within sixty days after the date of this Order.
