ORDER

In this proceeding Geo. Wm. Smith has made application to the Railroad Commission for a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the establishment of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers and freight between Orleans Bar and Harley Ranch via Langfords Ranch.

In connection with Application No. 6908 it was shown that applicant herein has been operating as a common carrier of passengers and freight over the territory above named for a period prior to the effective date of Chapter 213 Statutes of 1917, and continuously since and in accordance with Section 5 of the above named Chapter no certificate is required to continue such service. As applicant has already filed tariff of rates and time schedules covering the territory for which a certificate is sought in connection with the present application, such action is all that is required to establish operative right and accordingly the present

application will be dismissed.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be, and the same hereby is dismissed.
