O P I N I O N

Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company, a corporation, has applied to the Railroad Commission for authority to abandon and remove a certain spur track known as "Risher Spur" and located 3.4 miles easterly from Walnut Station and .8 of a mile west of Spadra Station. The verified application alleges that no passenger trains are scheduled to stop at Risher Spur; that there has been no freight traffic, either carload or less than carload, received at or forwarded from said spur during the period of twenty-four months preceding the date of the application; that the party for whom the spur was primarily constructed has requested removal of same, a copy of such request being attached as an exhibit to the application in this proceeding.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

O R D E R

Application having been made by the Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company, a corporation, for the abandonment and removal of the spur track known as "Risher Spur" and located at Risher, California, at a point intermediate between the stations of Walnut and Spadra, the Commission being fully advised and of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and the same hereby is granted.
