O P I N I O N

Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company, a corporation, has herein petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the discontinuance and abandonment of a shelter station heretofore maintained at Raymond, a point 1.5 miles west of Pasadena and three miles east of the station of Pisgah on the line of the applicants railroad.

The verified application sets forth that the shelter station, for which authority to abandon and discontinue is herein sought, was originally established to accommodate the patrons of the Raymond Hotel (a well-known tourist hotel in Pasadena) and Mr. Walter Raymond representing the hotel has consented to the abandonment of the shelter station. The application further alleges that during the twelve months preceding its date but fifteen people have left the trains of the applicant at this point and but twelve have boarded such trains. No freight or express matter is handled either to or from trains at this station and applicant alleges in view of the volume of passenger traffic heretofore handled that the requirements of the traveling public will be properly served by traffic heretofore handled at Raymond Station being diverted to and cared for by facilities of the agency station main-

tained by applicant in the City of Pasadena.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted in accordance with the following order.

O R D E R

Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company, a corporation, having applied to the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the discontinuance and abandonment of a shelter station on its line of railroad known as Raymond, California; the Commission being fully advised and of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and the same hereby is granted subject to the following condition:

Applicant, Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company, a corporation, will be required to post a notice of the proposed discontinuance of shelter station at its station of Raymond and at its agency stations at Los Angeles and Pasadena at least ten (10) days prior to the date upon which said Raymond Station will be abandoned, copy of such notice to be forwarded to the Railroad Commission for filing in this proceeding.
