O R D E R

W. C. Booth having made application to this Commission for authority to sell to N. M. Petersen the water plant and distribution system on a portion of Subdivisions 2 and 3 of Agua Caliente Park, Sonoma County, and N. M. Petersen having joined in the application,

And it appearing that the interests of the consumers will be better served if N. M. Petersen owns the water system, he being a resident on the premises and having conducted the business for the owner,

And it further appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary, and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that W. C. Booth be and he is hereby authorized to sell to N. M. Petersen a certain water plant and distributing system more particularly described in Appendix "A", attached hereto and made a part hereof, subject to the following conditions:

1. The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall have been made on or before February 1, 1922, and a certified copy of the instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by said W. C. Booth within thirty (30) days from the date on which it is executed.
2. Within ten (10) days from the date on which W. C. Booth actually relinquishes control and possession of the property herein authorized to be sold, he shall file with this Commission a certified statement indicating the date upon which such control and possession was relinquished.
3. The consideration given for the transfer of this water system shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of value of the property for rate fixing or for any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.
