Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, which is also engaged in selling water for irrigation and domestic purposes in Placer County, and Paramount Gold Mines Corporation, which is engaged in mining operations in Placer County, having filed an application with the Railroad Commission requesting approval of a written agreement, a copy of which is marked Exhibit "A" and attached to the application herein, said agreement having been entered into by and between the above mentioned parties and providing, among other things, for the sale and delivery of water to said Paramount Gold Mines Corporation for a three-year period from and after the date service was first delivered, said water used and to be used in connection with its mining operations near Wise

Power House and in quantity not to exceed two (2) minor's inches per day, at a rate of thirty cents ( $30^{\pm}$ ) per miner's inch per day (a minor's inch being equivalent to one and one-half ( $l_2^{\pm}$ ) cubic feet of water per minute, measured through any orifice), and it

appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,
